

Angels and Warfare

The teams who are engaged in intercession for the February event report sundry situations with angels.

A common question is what to do when there is an angelic/demonic battle going on, and it is not swift and decisive on the part of the angels.

In Daniel, there is one situation where an angelic battle was won when the lead angel got reinforcements from another angel. That suggests a principle that it is permissible to request more angels for a rumble.

I think that is a bit simplistic through. Permissible, but simplistic.

When you look at the book of Revelation, you will see time and again that truth is the issue.

God decides that angels should do X. The appropriate angel or group shows up; they are resourced with permission and assets, but they do not leave on assignment.

What they are waiting for is the **proclamation** of some truth in heaven. Once the right truth has been shouted or sung, then they go.

If we bring that principle over to this application, then when someone sees a battle in the spiritual realm, he or she should experiment with different proclamations about the nature and the works of God, while watching the battle.

When you see the critters getting ouched, you can double down in that spectrum of truth and support the good guys against the bad guys.
